Hmong Audio Bible

One of our main goals in Thailand is to disciple and train the Hmong to study the Bible for themselves. They tend to think that someone needs a Bible education/degree in order to share the Gospel and teach what the Bible says. Shortly before leaving in July, we realized that most of the Hmong in Naj Twm village, where we serve, do not know how to read Hmong. (It has only been a written language for about 50 years.) So, in order for them to hear the Gospel and God's Word, we would need to give it to them in some type of an audio format. One believer has shown interest in recording the New Testament in Hmong. He is very

dedicated but has little time to work on it. There may be resources available but we haven't found much that is specifically in the White Hmong dialect. If anyone knows of audio resources that are available in White Hmong, especially the Bible, please contact us. We are also looking for a thorough and accurate presentation of the Gospel. We have found a company that sells solar powered MP3 players that we can distribute to both believing and non-believing Hmong families. This may also give us the ability to share these players with Hmong in places where we cannot go.
