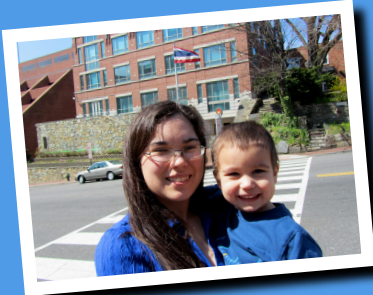

Our flight leaves on May 11 from New York with one stop in Seoul, South Korea, before landing in Chiang Mai, Thailand.

We have a complete Hmong Bible, but most of the Hmong in our village can't read it. Only 1% of the believers in Naj Twm village are literate. So we started "Project 316" a few months ago to address this issue. We also will bring essential Biblical teachings to give a solid foundation for all Hmong believers.

As part of our new visa requirements, we will be running a computer learning center in our home. We have graciously received two laptops from a prayer partner in Maryland!



Computer skills are desperately needed throughout Thailand, but the Hmong in our village have very few resources to help them

learn. Our plan is to invite a few Hmong kids to our home after school on Friday nights and teach basic computer skills (and of course have some time to play games.) This is also a great opportunity for us to learn Hmong and develop relationships with the kids and their families in order to build a bridge for sharing the Good News.

To date, we have received over \$1,400 to purchase the audio players already! We will place our first order soon and start uploading the players with information, such as a clear Gospel presentation, how to properly study and interpret the Bible, doctrinal teachings involving spiritual warfare, eternal security, etc. The New Testament from John to Revelation will also be uploaded. We have

a team of Hmong from the Lancaster, PA region who are helping us prepare the resources for these players. There is a lot of work involved, but we feel there will be a great demand for the players once word about them gets around. We look forward to the entire village hearing the Gospel clearly for the first time and for the Hmong to hear in other villages as well. We'll keep you posted.

PROJECT 316

John 3:16

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

WHAT IS PROJECT 316?

In Matthew 9:37 Jesus said, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few." Many villages in Thailand and other "creative access countries" do not have evangelists sharing the Gospel and giving them the foundational teachings that are necessary for a believer's walk with Christ. "Project 316" was designed to give the Hmong people access to the Bible and essential teachings of the Word of God via a solar-powered audio player capable of holding up to 320 hours of content. (The entire audio Bible is about 80 hours.) With the help of fluent Hmong speakers, we will be able to download essential teaching material and distribute the audio players to Hmong who want to hear the Gospel and believers who want to grow in their faith. Each audio player can be listened to by up to 10 people and is rugged enough to last 3 years. Just think of the potential! They are simple to use and the content can only be changed or deleted by the main unit, preventing others from using them for their own private use.



HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?

Each audio player costs about \$50.00 (this includes shipping and customs fees). If you would like to contribute (whatever amount) simply write out a check to "FIM" and in the memo section of your check simply write, "Project 316." Your gift is tax deductible and you will receive a receipt that you can fill out the next time you want to give. Please keep in mind that financial support is still needed for other ongoing expenses. If you would like to contribute to our monthly needs please write a separate check out to FIM but attach a post-it note or slip of paper stating "For Zeek's Ministry." Do not put our name anywhere on your check for tax purposes. Simply mail to FIM.
