Mark Cahill, author of, "One Thing You Can't do in Heaven" says this: "I can guarantee that there is one thing that you cannot do in Heaven that you can do on earth. You can worship God in Heaven. of Project 316 is like driving a car in the city. Although we are making some progress, we continue to run into roadblocks and traffic jams. Translating English to Hmong can sometimes be difficult because there are very few words in the Hmong language. So translating becomes a challenge. Please pray that the translators will have the ability and the time to translate.
