Though the wait has been long, we know it is all in God's perfect timing. After initial problems finding a translator to translate from English to Hmong, God pointed us to a woman in Chiang Mai who translated and recorded. Also, Hmong from Wisconsin and Pennsylvania visited us last May and helped with some translations. We also now have new players that use 4GB microSD cards that can easily be swapped out when we need to update them. (The previous model required a separate

computer to connect into each player and took 30 minutes to upload new material.) A friend of ours in Chiang Mai has started a division of MegaVoice in Thailand so we can purchase the players directly through Thailand, instead of paying a lot of money for shipping. And you, our prayer supporters, have faithfully prayed for this project, and many have

contributed towards buying one or more players. As you can see, many factors have come together by God's hand.

n December, we purchased 118 players from MegaVoice. Lord willing, our goal is to purchase another 132 players in 2013 bringing the total distribution to 300 players. The demand is increasing as more Hmong hear about this valuable resource. We already have requests from Hmong in Laos and Vietnam who desperately want the teachings that these players have. Some have asked how much it is to buy a player. We tell them that Christians in USA have generously paid for them. But we also say that they must use these players by listening and sharing the Gospel portion of the players with non-believers. In this way, they can show their gratitude and "pay" for a player. If they don't use them for this intended purpose, they are to give back the players.
