Project 316 What it may mean for the future

Although it has been nearly 2,000 years since Jesus told us that he will come back, in Revelation 1:1 it says that he will come back soon. This should not only be an encouragement for all believers, but it should also give us an urgency to tell others about the Gospel and teachings of God's Word. And prior to his coming back, Jesus will come to take his bride, the Church, with him sometime before the seven year

tribulational "day of the Lord" time period, of which much of the book of Revelation teaches us about, as well as a plethora of Old Testament prophetic scriptures. Knowing that the Rapture will take place suddenly, sometime before the Tribulation (Matthew 24:36; 1 Corinthians 15:51-52; 1 Thessalonians 1:10, 4:15-17; 2 Thessalonians 2:7; Revelation 3:10), and that all believers will be taken to be with Christ, most non-believers won't know what to think. Most of them will be deceived and come to believe that the Antichrist is the Messiah (2 Thessalonians 2:9-11). This includes many of the Hmong in S.E. Asia, who don't have any knowledge of what the Word of God says and will follow the Antichrist. This is one of the reasons as to why we need to distribute as many audio players as possible throughout S.E. Asia.



If a non-believer picks up a Project 316 audio player and starts listening to it, the first thing that they will hear will be a statement pertaining to the rapture and what is "soon" to come. Although the "rapture statement" is very brief, it will hopefully give the non-believer the motivation to learn more, not only about what will soon take place, but that they will be willing to listen to the clear message of the Gospel. For quite some time, believers will not be on the earth, but the audio players will.

In the past, non-believers have even

asked for a player as they overheard the believers listening to their audio players. Imagine what kind of impact these players can have, even if there are no believers present to share the Gospel and the teachings of God's Word with them. Let us be reminded that 99% of the Hmong don't know how to read the Hmong language. So, even though there may be some literature or even a Bible lying around, they won't know how to read it and wouldn't know where to begin. But with the audio player, they don't need to know how to read. All they have to do is turn it on and start listening. Just think, these audio players weren't even available 20 years ago.
