The Continued Success of Project 316!

It was quite a surprise to hear many of the great testimonies coming from our Hmong brothers and sisters in Southeast Asia regarding the Project 316 audio players! When many of the Hmong believers who live in Thailand go to Laos to visit family, they will bring their audio players with them in order to share some of the teachings that they have listened to. The Thai Hmong have discovered that the Lao Hmong are so hungry for the Word of God, they will often beg them for their audio player. Although they don't want to give up their player, they do out of love. Hopefully they can get a new player, but the demand for the players is increasing, and it may take some time to raise additional funds.

During this year's "Project 316 tour," Mike was able to distribute hundreds of audio players and update many players with an additional 85 hours of new audio (now totaling 265 hours). 114 players were distributed in Thailand and 131 in

Laos. Nearly all of the players that were distributed into Laos were placed into the hands of local elders who will take them across the Thailand/Laos border. They were given out during a biannual Bible leadership conference which took place in Northeast Thailand.

Players in Thailand were given to believers who live in the Chiang Rai area where each village received only one player last year. In April, there will be another 80 players that will go into the hands of even more leaders during a different biannual Bible conference for the Hmong from



Laos which takes place in northern Thailand. The total amount of players that have been given out or soon will be, comes to around 400!

The demand continues to grow!

Leaders have given us many names of those who need audio



players.

In August 2014, 50 players were distributed to the Hmong in Laos via the president of Northeastern Bible Seminary in Thailand. He has requested many more players. In addition, the Hmong from the Bible conference mentioned above are eagerly waiting for more audio

players for our brothers and sisters in Laos. And an elder from a village in Thailand asked for 50 players so that he can take them into Vietnam when he travels there. Currently, there are less than 20 players in Vietnam at this time due to the tight restrictions in this country, but progress is being made.

Thank you for all of your prayers and continued interest in teaching the Hmong the Word of God!

We will be sharing more in future letters. Until then, we hope that this newsletter continues to motivate you to support our ministry to the Hmong.
