The Power of the Word of God!

But for everyone of us who are true believers in Christ and are not deceived into believing the lies that false religions and false teachers promote, we can testify that the Word of God is powerful.

Within the Hmong culture, most Hmong hold on to the

religious traditions of their ancestors. Those of us in the western world tend to ignore the fact that there is an evil spiritual realm that is hard at work in destroying the lives of people. If you were to read Acts 19:13-16 (on page 2) to a Hmong person, they would have no problem relating to the events that happened that day. But most of us today have never seen anything like this take place. The Hmong, however, realize the power that demonic spirits have. Many of the

Hmong are afraid of the spirits and of what would happen if they believed in the Gospel. So they continue to live in fear every day and do their best to not offend the spirits that live in

their homes, villages and in the forests around them. They believe that spirits are everywhere.

An elder from Laos said,

“When my mother was sick for four years, we did every demon ceremony possible to make her well, but she never

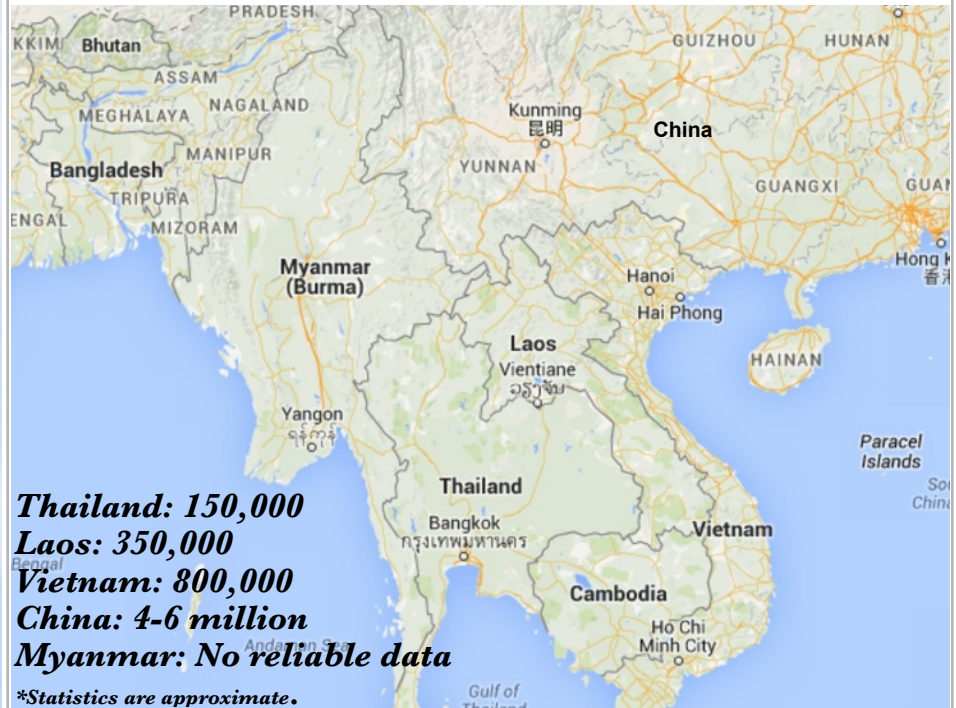

got better." His family knew that the demons were powerful, but they couldn't heal her. So they started learning more about Jesus. Although he didn't say whether or not his mother was healed, the family believed in the Gospel and he said, "when we decided to believe, Jesus delivered us from the darkness; from the oppressiveness of the demonic world." He tells a simple straight forward testimony, but through Christ, he and his family have been dramatically changed for all eternity. He is one of the believers who has received a Project 316 audio player. After listening to it, he has requested many more for the believers who live in his area where he serves.

Many of our Hmong brothers and sisters are hungry for the

Word of God, but they don't have the resources to purchase a player for themselves. As far as we can figure, only 1-2% of the Hmong in Southeast Asia are believers. Even in this small minority, we could potentially need over 100,000 players. We have distributed just over 650 units so far, and we have many more on waiting lists. Please pray and consider how you can make an impact in the lives of those who need to hear God's Word.
