



Challenging Conditions

While various places in the US have seen their fair share of devastation from hurricanes and the immense amount of rainfall (which is also putting central/eastern Pennsylvania into the record books), our Hmong brothers and sisters in southeast Asia, who live high up in the mountains, also have to deal with the onslaught of the rainy season every year. When the monsoon season is in full swing, flooding is common and travel is extremely difficult. Many villages are not accessible for several months at a time, which can

potentially hinder or delay Project 316 audio players from getting into the hands of those who need them. With unpaved roads and slippery clay soil, it certainly makes travel interesting. Most of our ministry partners only have motorbikes and do the best they can under these conditions. Oftentimes roads get blocked due to mudslides and falling rock, but that hasn't stopped our team from delivering audio players. However, the amount of requests for more audio players is overwhelming. When one of our





ministry team members get a shipment of players and distributes them to local and remote villages, they always return asking for more! The initial requests of more than 5,000+ players at Yexusfest 14 months ago has continued to increase and honestly, we don't have any idea just how many are in need of an audio player. We are certainly making headway with over 2,300 audio players distributed to date, but there are so many others still

waiting for a Project 316 andio player. We haven't even begun trying to get the players into China, which is where there are an estimated 4-6 million Hmong!

As part of the Moua clan (of which there are 18 total clans), each year we get together for our annual Thanksgiving meal. Although, due to scheduling it came earlier than usual this year, we had a great time and certainly continue to count it as a privilege to be part of the Moua clan.
