

Project 316 Ministry Team Member Spotlight!

Without Project 316 Ministry Team members, Project 316 wouldn't be possible. But who are they, exactly? In this newsletter and other future newsletters, we will highlight those who are playing pivotal roles behind the scenes and share with you how they became believers and have impacted the world for Christ.

Meet Bee (Hmong: Npis)

As a young child, Bee and his family were forced to escape to Thailand because of the Vietnam War and Secret War in Laos which took place in the 1970's. His family lived in a refugee camp for about five years. His family was granted permission to relocate to Philadelphia in 1981 along with a

few other families. In 2002, they moved out of Philadelphia and came to live in Lancaster County, PA.

Bee grew up in a "Christian" household and was active in a local church, though he didn't become a true believer until about 2012. Within the church he attended, he started asking a lot of questions pertaining to salvation. Unfortunately, the leadership couldn't provide him with sufficient answers to his questions from the Bible. They didn't know what true salvation was. [A couple of years ago, I talked to someone from that church and based on what I learned from Bee, I discussed the Gospel with this individual. He wouldn't accept

the simple fact that salvation is based on faith not works (Ephesians 2:8-9). He kept coming back to the fact that he would be granted eternal life because he was a good person and helped others.] So Bee was on his own. Fortunately, he was relentless in his search for answers.
