They've desperately wanted more audio players for a long time, but since the demand is so high, we can only afford to give out a limited number. Some are also receiving the micro-SD cards so that they can use them in their cellphones, but the majority (especially those who live up in the mountains) still have need for an audio player. Entire villages haven't received any audio players, but they have heard about them and sincerely desire to have one for themselves.
